Terms and conditions:

- Scholarships and bursaries are not applicable with any other offer.
- Deferral or not accepting this scholarship or bursary offer forfeits this offer.
- A leave of absence or gap in studies, unless expressly approved, forfeits this offer. Requests for leave will be assessed on a case-by-case basis and consideration will be taken into whether the bursary offer shall be extended.
- This offer is only valid for the course enrolled in upon accepting this offer and will not rollover if a student is to change their course.
- This bursary is offered to full fee-paying students only and will be withdrawn for students on a payment plan.
- Available to new applicants only.
- This bursary offer is available to International Students commencing studies online from their home countries in Session 3, November 2021, in any of the following courses:
 - Diploma of Arts, Diploma of Media and Communications, Diploma of Business Administration, Diploma of Information Technology, Diploma of Engineering or
 - Foundation Program (Standard) or Foundation Program (Extended)
- This bursary offer is valid when students apply and accept their offer to commence in Session 3, 2021 before 5PM AEST on 22 October 2021.
- This bursary is valued up to 15% off your course fees, for the first 8 subjects for any of the Diploma programs and Foundation Program (Extended) and for the first 4 subjects for the Foundation Program (Standard). If a student is required to repeat a subject, the 9th unit will be charged at full price.
- The bursary has been applied to a standard of four units (subjects) with the initial Letter of Offer, the amount will be adjusted to reflect the final course load when enrolment is completed for session one. If enrolment is less than four units, the adjustment will add credit to the student's account, ultimately reducing fees owing for the following session.
- This bursary is offered by SIBT and can be withdrawn at the discretion of the provider.
- The bursary will be applied as a reduction to the enrolled unit fees each session and cannot be withdrawn or exchanged for cash.
